Single Stage Two Envelop Bidding Process shall be adopted. Detail of bidding procedure is available in the Tender Documents. Interested parties are invited to obtain Tender Documents against a written request on Company's Letterhead with copies of valid EPA licence, NTN & GST certificates and on payment of Rs. 500/- (non-refundable) during 1000 hrs to 1200 hrs and 1400 hrs to 1600 hrs Monday through Friday from **13 to 28 March 2017** from Warehouse, Corporate Headquarters Korangi Creek Road, Karachi.

The Hazardous Material can be inspected by bidders at their own cost and arrangements, Monday through Friday from **13 to 28 March 2017** between 1000 hrs to 1200 hrs at Uphill Warehouse PS-1 located at Korangi Creek Road, Karachi.

Bids must be accompanied by a Bid Bond in the form of Bank Draft or Pay Order (cash or cheque are not acceptable) drawn in favour of **Pak-Arab Refinery Limited** in an amount equal to **5% (Five Percent)** of the total Bid value. Bids submitted without Bid Bond shall not be accepted. Sealed bids addressed to the Manager Materials, Pak-Arab Refinery Limited must be deposited in the Tender box placed for this purpose at main security gate of PARCO's Corporate Headquarters, Korangi Creek Road, Karachi up to 1500 hrs on **17 April 2017**. Technical proposals with bids will be opened at 1530 hrs on the same day in the presence of bidders or their authorized representatives. Bids submitted without Bid Bond shall not be accepted. Bid Bond of successful bidders who fail to make payment of the bid amount or fail to lift the Hazardous Material in time specified in Tender document shall be forfeited. Commercial proposals of only technically qualified bidders shall be opened in the presence of bidder(s)' representatives at a later date after the evaluation of Technical Proposal. Technical and Commercial proposals should be valid for 90 days.

PARCO reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids and to cancel the bidding process, at any time prior to the award of Contract, and is liable to communicate to any contractor upon its request, the grounds of rejection but is not required to justify those grounds.
